## Fork Guard Kit Assembly

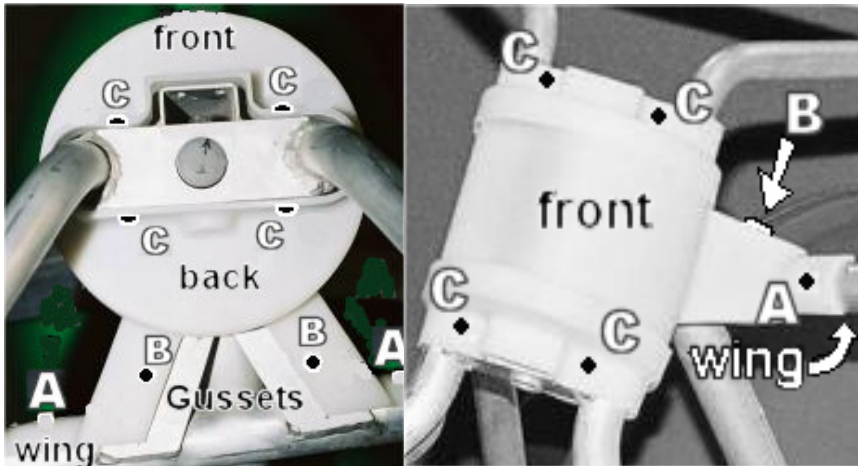
These instructions are to guide you when installing the fork guard. Since there is some variation between models, the fork guard may need to be adjusted or adapted to work on your specific Aqua-Cycle.

You should have one fork guard that goes around the fork turning area, four covers to go above and below the guard enclosing the turning area entirely and the screws and washers for attaching these parts. Holes will need to be drilled for the screws. Use a drill bit  $1\frac{1}{64}^{\text{th}}$ , which is appropriate for a #10 sheet metal screw so it will thread itself into the hole and remain tight.

Put the guard around the fork turning area so the angle of the guard matches that of the fork and the fork can turn within the guard.

(A) Push each wing toward the center and drill a hole through each wing and the front edge of the frame tube. Use one screw and washer to hold each wing in place.

(B) Drill a hole and use one screw and washer for each top gusset (support bracket from the frame to the neck tube), securing each wing to the gusset.



Notice that the two covers for the front match the U-Channel on the front. The back bottom cover has slits for the reinforcing bars along the backside of the fork legs. With some older Aqua-Cycles the back bottom cover cannot be used.

(C) Drill two holes through the face of each cover and into the fork. Install each cover with two screws and washers.
